2020 CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) PRECAUTIONS

Dothan Hematology and Oncology is closely monitoring the global COVID-19 outbreak. Our goal is to ensure a safe place for our patients, their families and our employees.

FOR OUR PATIENTS:

To better protect you, your family and staff, we are reducing the number of people at our Healthwest office, including visitors. We are rescheduling many non-urgent and patient appointments. However, many appointments and treatments should proceed as planned. You may receive a call the day before your appointment asking questions about potential symptoms, risk and/or exposure.

- Ask if there are visits you should postpone.
- Reschedule your appointment if family members are sick and the visit is not required for therapy.

We will ask about symptoms of illness and potential exposure to the virus at check-in.

Because COVID-19 poses a health risk, we are not allowing visitors to accompany the patient inside the office unless there are circumstances that require assistance.

You should not come to our facility if you or any members of your household have **any** of the following symptoms:

- Fever (suspected or actual temperature of 100.4°F/38.0°C or greater)
- Cough
- Difficulty breathing
- Sore throat
- Runny nose

You should call the office first for instructions on next steps. **HOWEVER**, if you believe your symptoms are life threatening, please call 911 for emergency assistance.
